

### **hESC Lines Released for Clinical Development**

February 27th saw the launch of the first <u>EUTCD-Grade</u> cell lines; MasterShef 2, MasterShef 7 and MasterShef 10. These cell lines have been derived and banked under conditions which meet the EU tissue and cells directive making them suitable for development into advanced therapies. This represents a major milestone in the achievements of the UKSCB and its partners, and is a reflection of the hard work by everyone involved.
